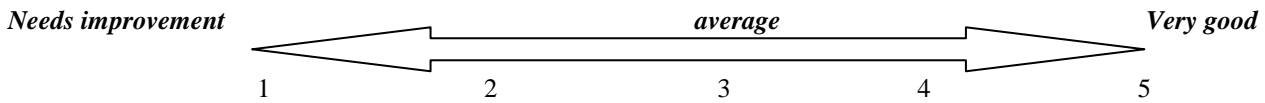
→ Have the students evaluate the man speaking concerning #4 - #8 on the following evaluation grid (we don't need to HEAR him speak for this)
